Avoid Common Scams in 2024!

Throughout the year ElderWatch tracks the most common reports of fraud and scams from older Coloradans. In 2023, ElderWatch received thousands of these reports. The following are the most common scams reported by older Coloradans and a few things you should know about each scam:

- 1. Identity Theft: Criminals steal personal and financial information from their victims online, in-person, in the mail and through data breaches. To know: Take preventative steps to protect your identity, learn more at www.identitytheft.gov.
- 2. Impostor Business: Scammers pose as well-known businesses (commonly Amazon) to try and obtain money and personal information. To know: Most businesses will not contact you unsolicited. If in doubt, contact them independently with known information.
- 3. Tech Support/Computer Virus: Scammers try and convince victims that there is a problem with their computer or account, and they pose as a familiar company and say they can fix it. To know: Never let an unknown and/or unsolicited entity remotely access your computer, tablet or smartphone.
- 4. Fraudulent Sales: Criminals set up fake websites or sell items online without the intention of ever supplying the product or providing a faulty product. To know: Do your research before doing business with any unfamiliar entity. If the deal sounds too good to be true, it is!
- 5. Sweepstakes/Prize/Lottery: Scammers tell their victim that they won a prize, all they must do is send money to retrieve it. To know: Never send money to receive money!

Tax-Aide volunteers are located nationwide, and are trained and IRS-certified every year to make sure they know about and understand the latest changes and additions to the tax code. Question: Is AARP Foundation Tax-Aide available this year?

Answer: Yes, generally Tax-Aide service will run from February 1 to April 15.

Question: Can Tax-Aide help file my taxes?

Answer: AARP Foundation Tax-Aide volunteers can help with most, but not all, tax returns. If you have an extremely complicated return, such as one that involves a small business with employees, rental income, or alternative minimum tax (AMT), Tax-Aide may not be able to help. See what type of taxes we can prepare.
